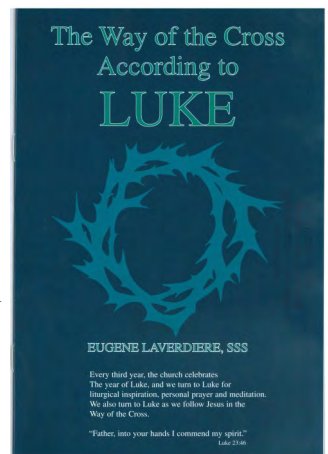
ANOINTING OF THE SICK OFFERED

Stations of the Cross will be offered twice each Friday during Lent at **3:00 pm** and again at **7:00 pm**. One of our common religious struggles is to realize that we are not alone. The Good News is that Jesus entered into our life's experience completely - even suffering and death - and that he fell into the hands of a Loving God, who raised him from death to life. We can have complete hope that suffering and death have no complete hold on us. We will all share eternal life with him, if we can fall into the hands of the same Loving God. And, along the way, we are not alone. Jesus is with us as one who knows our suffering, and the death we face. That can be deeply consoling. So try the stations, and experience the consolation they offer. And return often, to be renewed in this intimate experience of Jesus' solidarity with all humanity in our way of the cross each day.

World Marriage Day, as we observe it today, reminds us that the “Holy Scriptures affirms that man and woman were created for one another: ‘It is not good that man should be alone.’ The woman, ‘flesh of his flesh’, that is, his counterpart, his equal, his nearest in all things, is given to him by God as a ‘helpmate’; she thus represents God from whom comes our help. ‘Therefore a man leaves his father and his mother and cleaves to his wife, and they become one flesh.’ The Lord himself shows that this signifies an unbreakable union of their two lives by recalling what the plan of the Creator had been ‘in the beginning’: So they are no longer two, but one flesh.” (CCC1605)

Marriage is discipleship. Married couples can fulfill God’s plan and God’s will as they give of themselves to one another in imitation of Jesus Christ. They are to love each other to the end. This means that they have to make their love open to further growth and development until it is conformed, perfected and united to the love of Jesus Christ for us.

The St. Joseph Parish Collection and the St. Joseph School Collection will remain open.

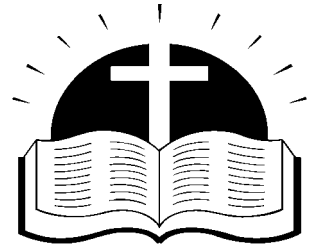
