Third Sunday of Easter

Scripture Readings

Dear brothers and sisters,

Peace in the risen Lord!

In our gospel reading for this Sunday Jesus affirms Peter to be the shepherd of the flock. Jesus' thrice repeated question, "Simon, son of John, do you love me?" echoes Peter's threefold denial of Jesus. Jesus wants to have a fresh start with Peter as he assumes the role of being the shepherd of the Lord's flock. Peter's response about his love for Jesus now depends on the Lord's knowledge of him. Now Peter would rely only on the Lord, even if he can truly confess his love for him.



Shepherding demands not just feeding the flock, it also requires one's life for the sheep. It takes a lot of love to imitate the example shown to us by Jesus, our risen Lord.
