

5th Sunday of Easter – 2024 (B)

Remain in My Love

In this Sunday's Gospel, we hear Jesus telling his disciples" "I am the Vine." To the jews of his time, they pride themselves as the chosen vineyard of the Lord. Israel was the vine transplanted from Egypt by God and took care of it until it flourished. As the vine, Jesus reminds his listener of God's loving concern for His people. In Him his disciples will find nourishment because He connects us to the roots of the plant and the garden, which is the life-giving medium for any plant. But this will only be true, if as disciples of Jesus, we see ourselves as branches that cling to the vine. And very truly that separated from the vine, we will have no life in us. That is why how important it is that we remain in him – "Remain in me as I remain in you. Remain in my love"

But in the life of the vine, another reality that we must contend it with is the cycle of pruning. In pruning, we take away that which eats up the nutrients that should go to the bearing of fruits. No different from what we must prune from our lives such as the unnecessary habits or way of living or preoccupations that take us away from meaningful moments that could have been spent with God and doing His works. We can't flourish if we haven't trimmed away the excess, haven't pruned the clutter, haven't focused on remaining connected to the true vine.

When being pruned in life let us not despair. For as a good bishop once said: "Little to suffer, little to offer. Much to suffer, much to offer. Nothing to suffer, nothing to offer."






The Hot Meal committee would like to thank everyone who contributed and/or helped with our April Hot Meal in any way. We served 344 plates in total.
